- Leonardo was born in 1452 near Vinci in Italy.

- He became very good at painting. Leonardo helped Verroccio paint many of his best works.

- A duke in Milan noticed Leonardo's talent. He paid him to create paintings. 'The Last Supper' is one of the most famous works Leonardo painted for him.

- He also drew human bodies and machines.
 He was the first person to draw an idea for a helicopter!
