This week we learnt the following with a grown-up...

- *To explore the composition of numbers within 10, focusing on the 'special case' of when 2 equal parts combine to make a whole.
- *To identify when 2 sets are equal or NOT equal
- *To see a range of familiar representations including dice and fingers and to explore the idea of '2 equal parts', and then find the whole by combining these parts.
- *To continue to use our subitising skills, and begin to 'know' the whole when we see 2 parts the same size for larger numbers within 10
- *To recall some doubles facts when an image or physical resource is not available
- *To make a double pattern on our fingers, matching our fingers to 'check' that the same number is shown on each hand
- * To revisit the phoneme igh (as in high) and oa (as in goat) and practise reading and writing them in CVC (consonant, vowel, consonant) and CVCC (consonant, vowel, consonant) words

Eg. night nights bright flight goat goats float

- * There are 5 vowels a, e, i, o, u and we need to know these to help us with our spelling rules later on
- * To read the tricky word have and like
- * To recall our knowledge on Dorset and learn that it is home to the Jurassic Coast, which is famous for being a site to find fossils
- * To find out about local fossil hunter, Mary Anning. To learn more about her life, her discoveries and the impact she's had on history.
